Key achievements to date:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity

- Midday Supervisors have had training on active lunchtimes
- Some children have had training on mini-leader training programme
- Introduction of Anomaly screen on playgrounds

2. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered

- Range of after school clubs on offer to pupils
- All year groups have the opportunity to attend sporting events and festivals enabling children to take part (inclusive of SEN).
- Qualified sports coach running weekly sports sessions.

3. Increased participation in competitive sport

- Attending a variety of sports events run by Derbyshire County council and High Peak sports partnership
- Developed both a girls and boys football team
- Developed a Cheerleading group which has entered competitions
- Taken part in national incentive change4life

- Daily physical activity for all pupils national recommendation for 30 minutes per day
- Staff training to support the delivery of PE and confidence
