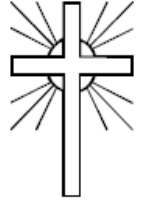

Requiem Mass for HM Queen Elizabeth II

Bishop Patrick will celebrate Holy Mass for the Repose of the Soul of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II this Sunday, 18th September, at 6pm in St Barnabas Cathedral, Nottingham, NG1 5AE.

Today, Sunday 18th September, is Evangelii Gaudium Sunday – Celebrating the Beauty of our Faith.

In the past, the third Sunday in September has been known as '**Home Mission Sunday**'. This has now changed to Evangelii Gaudium Sunday to better reflect the Pope Francis' first (solo) Apostolic Exhortation on the Joy of the Gospel, and the day offers the Catholic community in England and Wales the opportunity to celebrate the beauty of our faith and our commitment to witness to the fullness of life in Christ.

The second collection this Sunday is important in financing the work of the Mission Department at the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, and in enabling the local Church to make the Joy of the Gospel a reality. Over the past two years the emphasis has moved towards supporting diocesan co-ordinators in their work.

Care for our Common Home:

The first session of this course, exploring some key themes of 'Laudato Si', was well attended and provided an interesting and very thought provoking evening.
