

World Day of the Poor

Pope Francis has declared Sunday 13th November 2022 to be the sixth World Day of the Poor, with the theme of "For your sakes Christ became poor" (2 Cor 8:9).

In his message for this World Day of the Poor, Pope Francis reflects on the words of St Paul to the Church in Corinth and invites Christians to greater solidarity and responsibility for the poor. "That is precisely what solidarity is: sharing the

little we have with those who have nothing, so that no one will go without. The sense of community and of communion as a style of life increases and a sense of solidarity matures." Pope Francis notes that the year comes:

"as a healthy challenge, helping us to reflect on our style of life and on the many forms of poverty all around us."
