Fr Martin writes,

It's that time of year when we remember with special devotion those of our loved ones who have died. May they rest in peace.

If I want my mum and dad, may they rest in peace, to have a share in every Holy Souls Mass offered in the year ahead, I put a note with their names, along with my offering, in one of the "Month of the Holy Souls November Dead List" envelopes.

Then, every time I see that Holy Mass is offered for the Holy Souls, I know they have a share in that Mass.

If I want them to have one Holy Mass offered for the repose of their souls, then I use the ordinary Mass Offering envelope, the type that is printed with a space for names to be written on the outside of the envelope.

It is perfectly fine to use an ordinary envelope, giving clear instructions, for example,

"My offering for Holy Souls Masses. Please include [names] RIP in all the Holy Souls Masses" or "My offering for Holy Mass to be offered for the repose of the soul of [name] RIP."

Envelopes should be returned to Royle House, Church Street, Glossop SK13 7RJ or put in the weekly collection.

People can also go online to arrange Mass offerings or add names to the Holy Souls list. Please visit paypal.me/fathermartin and use the form of words that is recommended above when using an ordinary envelope.

When you work your way through the simple steps to submit your offering, do not tick "paying for goods or a service" -- we never pay for Holy Mass!

The price of every Mass ever to be celebrated was paid by Jesus Christ with his Precious Blood on Calvary.

Our offering for a Mass is a gift to cover, or at least contribute to, the priest's living expenses for the day he offers Holy Mass for our requested intention.

The Holy Father's Prayer Intentions for November:

We pray for all children who suffer, those who are homeless, orphaned, or victims of war; may they have access to education and the opportunity to experience family affection.

Our prayers are asked for the repose of the soul of Fr John Sullivan, who died recently.

Fr Sullivan was ordained priest in 1954, and served in Chesterfield, Derby, Nottingham, Leicester, Marple Bridge and finally in Hadfield, from where he retired in 1999.

Bishop Patrick will be the principal celebrant of Fr Sullivan's funeral on Monday (see diary section for details). Canon Don Bowdren will receive Fr Sullivan's body into St Charles church at 6.00pm on Sunday night; this vigil ceremony is not a Mass.
