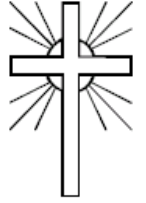

## **Fr Martin writes, Dr Helena Rakicka RIP**

Last week we prayed for the repose of the soul of Dr Helena Rakicka, and last week's newsletter went to press before her funeral arrangements had been announced.

We are now able to report that, God willing, Dr Rakicka's body will be received into St Mary Crowned by Canon Don Bowdren at 7pm on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> December, and her Funeral Mass will be celebrated by Fr Martin, with Canon Don concelebrating, at 10.15am on Friday 16<sup>th</sup>.

*May her soul, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.*

## **Fr Martin writes, Confession the easy way:**

At a time of year when we are thinking what the people we love would like as a gift, we remember how Jesus tells us (in the parable of the Prodigal Son and many other places elsewhere in the scriptures) that the gift which will most delight the Father is our repentance, when we accept His offer not only to forgive our sins but also, by the working of the Holy Spirit, to restore within in us what we have damaged: that share of divine life by which we are made God's sons and daughters, destined for eternal joy. Before the pandemic some people made Advent and Lent services of reconciliation a regular part of their Christian discipleship, and many people find that a reconciliation service is the easiest way back to confession after a period away.

Readings and an examination of conscience help us confront our own sinfulness and renew our trust in the mercy of God; a choice of priests are present, for individual confession; and then we all stay to give thanks together for the forgiveness of sin and restoration of innocence that Christ gives us in this mighty sacrament.

Our Advent reconciliation service is on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> December at St Mary Crowned Church at 3pm.

All of the priests assisting will be just as welcoming to someone who last went to confession forty years ago as they will be to someone who was at the sacrament of reconciliation last Saturday.
