

Dear Parents,

Welcome back! I hope you had a lovely summer break and a good rest. I have lots of lovely learning opportunities planned for this year which I am sure that your children will enjoy.

Each class will have a Forest Schools session every half-term this year and from next Friday, the 13<sup>th</sup>, parents and carers will be invited to all Good News Assemblies on Fridays unless something out of the ordinary is happening!

On the 24<sup>th</sup> September, Year 5 children will complete Playground Leaders training with a coach who will come into school so P.E. kit will be needed that day.

#### How can you help your child this year?

- Please see overleaf for a snapshot of what your child's learning will look like this half-term. Please keep this letter and chat to your child about their learning.
- Weekly homework and spellings will be distributed on Fridays. Please set aside time for your child to complete these as they are a consolidation of what has been learned in class.
- Listen to your child read for 15 minutes per day and ask a few questions about what they have read. There are questions on the inside of their reading diary to help.
- Ask your child multiplication tables questions every day. Encourage them to practise on EdShed.
- Remind your child to bring their swimming kit, P.E kit, Forest Schools kit on the correct days and to bring both their reading book and diary to school daily. Training your child to be responsible for their own belongings is good practice for secondary school.

#### Weekly Routine

MONDAY	Swimming for <u>all Year 4 children</u> . Earrings must be removed and long hair tied back. Forest Schools sessions will be on a Monday afternoon. A text will be sent out in advance.
TUESDAY	P.E.- <b>School kit must be worn</b> , earrings removed and long hair tied back. In the afternoon, Mrs Fletcher will be covering my planning time and will dismiss the children at the end of the day.
THURSDAY	Number of reads with an adult will be counted by Mrs Done.
FRIDAY	<b>Good News Assembly 9.00a.m. Everyone welcome from next Friday 13<sup>th</sup>!</b> <b>Spelling test, times tables test, Century work to be completed.</b> New spelling and Century work will be set.
