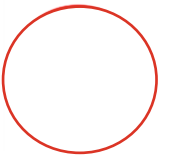


# History Knowledge Organiser Y1/2 – The History of Space Travel

| <b>Tourist</b>   | A person who is visiting a place for pleasure and interest                |
| <b>Travel</b>    | When you go from one place to another, often to a place that is far away. |

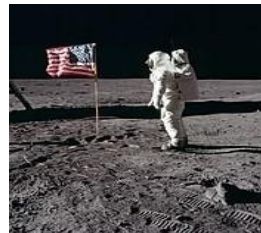

| 1947 | First animals sent to <b>space</b> . They were fruit flies sent on some corn.                                                                            |
| 1949 | The first monkey is sent to <b>space</b> .                                                                                                               |
| 1955 | The <b>Space Race</b> begins between Russia and America                                                                                                  |
| 1957 | The first animal goes around the Earth in <b>space</b> . It is a dog named Laika.                                                                        |
| 1961 | First man in <b>space</b> . His name was <b>Yuri Gagarin</b>                                                                                             |
| 1963 | First woman in <b>space</b> . Her name was <b>Valentina Tereshkova</b>                                                                                   |
| 1969 | Moon Landing.<br><br>Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin become the first people to walk on the moon. The first words they said were, "The Eagle has landed." |
| 1991 | Helen Sharman becomes the first British <b>astronaut</b> in <b>space</b> .                                                                               |
