Reading

If your child is in Year 1, they have come home with a reading book and record. We encourage you to listen to your child read each night. Each read will be acknowledged with a Gold Stamp. Your child will be rewarded after 50 reads, 100 reads, 150 reads and 200 reads.

Children in Reception will receive a book to share with you at home from the school library. These count towards reads. The children will receive a reading book over the next few weeks.

Reading regularly builds confidence and fluency and supports the hard work they do in school!

Homework

Reception and Year 1 children will come home with their homework on a Friday and we ask that it is handed in the following Friday.

Each half-term, your child's RE Knowledge Organiser will be sent home to allow you to see their learning in more detail.

P.E.

Your child will have their PE session on a Wednesday morning. The children's PE kit is a white t-shirt, black jogging bottoms and jacket. Please make sure their PE kits are in school; we will send these home at the end of term to be washed.

Uniform
