MOBILE PHONES

Spellings will be set each Monday and are tested the following Monday. The children also have weekly tasks set on Century, which they have a login for.

Other homework will be set on paper on Mondays. This will be an English or maths task, which is in a folder they bring home and return on Mondays for marking. Getting the children used to bringing in homework tasks helps them prepare for secondary school. In addition, Y6 pupils will have SAT practice work and an after-school SAT club after Christmas to help prepare them.

They also have their Times Tables Rock Stars logins to access lots of activities to support their learning in class.
