

Changes from Version 1.0 to Version 2.0 (January 2025)

- Updated review dates to reflect the new policy cycle
- Added the Online Safety Bill (2024) to the legislation and regulation section
- Added detailed KCSIE-aligned filtering and monitoring requirements, with clarification that digital monitoring tools are supplemental to, not a replacement for, physical staff supervision
- Added a new AI Usage section (Section 5) covering: definitions of AI tools, prohibition of student use on Trust devices, acceptable and unacceptable uses for staff, and monitoring provisions
- Made MFA mandatory for all staff where available and feasible, with personal devices required for the authenticator app and a fallback option via mobile number where approved
- Tightened USB and external drive restrictions, limiting use to exceptional circumstances under IT supervision and emphasising cloud-based data transfer via OneDrive and SharePoint
- Enhanced BYOD requirements to require unmanaged devices to connect to an isolated guest network only, with the internal network PSK restricted to IT staff and Trust-managed devices

Changes from Version 2.0 to Version 2.1 (March 2026)

- Updated policy to comply with JCQ exam regulation requirements
