How can you help your child this year?

- Please see overleaf for a snapshot of what your child's learning will look like this half-term. Please keep this letter and chat to your child about their learning.
- Weekly homework and spellings will be distributed on Fridays. Please set aside time for your child to complete these as they are a consolidation of what has been learned in class.
- Listen to your child read for 15 minutes per day and ask a few questions about what they have read. There are questions of the inside of their reading diary to help.
- **Ask your child multiplication tables questions every day. Encourage them to practise on EdShed. There is one final push before the end of the year, to make sure the children are as fluent in their multiplication as they can be. Being fluent in the multiplication tables helps with confidence in all areas of maths.**
- Remind your child to bring their swimming kit, P.E kit, Forest Schools kit on the correct days and to bring both their reading book and diary to school daily. Training your child to be responsible for their own belongings is good practice for secondary school.
